Ending Impunity

More resources, coordination for personnel and agencies detecting grand corruption

Illicit Financial Flows

Transparency on the information chain from beneficial ownership disclosure to sharing of tax information

Transparency of Financial Systems

Every country should have a publicly available register showing the beneficial ownership of the companies registered there, every bank obliged to use these to identify the real owners of the accounts they manage



Political Lobbying

Transparency in lobbying public bodies is the best way to ensure accountability in decision-making

Whistleblower Support

A whistleblower support network linking civil society, media and investigators could provide cross-border protection

Climate Change

Measurement, reporting and verification procedures must be developed for deforestation and forest degradation



Corruption in Sport

Create an international agency to address match-fixing in sport and strengthen transnational regulation of the betting industry.

Development

Integrate corruption risk assessments into Millennium Development Goals and promote broader participation

Education

Make education more transparent to build trust, advance anti-corruption curricula in higher education



Land Rights

Governments, companies should use new voluntary land tenure guidelines to work with citizens

Corruption: an International Crime

Corruption is a human rights issue that could be pursued as a an international crime, as well as through civil legal action

People

People can make a difference in pushing through reforms, asserting rights or helping disclose and punish corrupt acts



Technology

ICTs expand the ability of citizens to organize and mobilize, to monitor track and hold to account

New coalitions

Citizen engagement can open new coalitions, networks and fronts for action, from community organizers to sports clubs

Young leaders

Supporting a new generation of anti-corruption reformers involves a focus on education, inclusion and openness to new ideas
